Church Ceremony:

Parent/Baby Dedication in worship service

Target Age Range: 0-2 Years Old

The Objective:

Understanding your role as the primary faith trainer for your children and family

Parent Seminar:

This seminar covers topics like: God's plan for families, the purpose of the parent/baby dedication, our calling as parents, leading as the "primary faith trainer" in my home, dad's role and mom's role, and ways to build biblical foundations.

(This class is a pre-requisite for the Parent/Baby Dedication. You must be a church member to participate in the dedication.)

Celebration Description:

The Church Ceremony is a time where parents have the opportunity to make meaningful commitments in front of each other and in front of the entire church family. The Ceremony includes a brief bio about each family, the reciting of commitments by dads, moms, and the congregation, and a special time of prayer over the children. Each family receives a gift from the church as a means of remembrance and celebration. This service takes place on Mother's Day each year.
